We joined the Community Concert Association, a nationwide organization that brokered performances and entertainers to small towns at a time when gas was rationed and money was scarce and few people could pay the price to go to the big city. Top-rated acts and beginning talent were brought into towns throughout the Midwest, and small farm towns on the plains could go to the local stages and see the likes of Fred Waring, Cab Calloway, symphonies, ballets, and small scale musicals. These graced our town three to four times each year for 70 years.

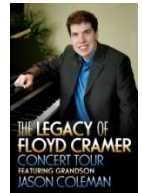
